"I am convinced that the particular context of Ephesians 3 elucidates the most likely meaning of width, length, height, and depth. Right before this phrase, Paul mentions "being rooted and established in love" (3: 17). Right afterwards he asks that his readers might "know this love that surpasses knowledge" (3: 19). Thus the context on either side of the multidimensional phrase is love."






